

\$1.9 MILLION VERDICT AGAINST THE CITY OF FT. LAUDERDALE
in
Negligent Police Chase Case

Isham v. The City of Ft. Lauderdale Police Dept.
Broward County Case No.: 03-007988 (02)

Angela Isham, the surviving spouse and personal representative for the estate of David Isham, received the verdict after a 6-day jury trial in the Seventeenth Judicial Circuit. The City of Ft. Lauderdale Police Department (FTLPD) was represented by Clark Cochran.

Mrs. Isham's Complaint alleged that the FTLPD was negligent in pursuing a suspect while the officers were operating an unmarked car in a highly congested area. Mrs. Isham's husband, David, a local landscaping and pest control business owner was killed when a fleeing suspect hit him as he returned home from work.

Immediately after the accident and at trial, the FTLPD denied that there was ever a pursuit at all.

The fleeing suspect was held 50% at fault.
